COUNCIL TAPS CELT PRESIDENT FOR INSTRUCTIONAL INITIATIVE

MARLBOROUGH, MA APRIL 29, 2008: Rick Rozzelle, President and Chief Technology Officer of the Center for Educational Leadership and Technology (CELT), has been named an instructor at the SEA University, the innovative new training program offered by the Council of Chief State School Officers (CCSSO). Jim Goodell, an Executive Vice President with CELT leading the development of enterprise-class solutions in support of teaching, learning, and education leadership, has been named an additional presenter.
